PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

An Associate in Science Degree in Elementary Teacher Education for Transfer prepares students for transfer into a baccalaureate level degree at any of the California State University campuses. The Elementary Teacher Education program prepares students for jobs teaching in the Kindergarten through eighth (-8) grades in the public and private education system. While the programs curriculum allows for the development of knowledge and skills in the subject matter taught in the K-8 grades, students must ultimately complete a multiple subject credential usually after their Bachelor's degree in addition to passing the CBEST and CSET exams.

Students who wish to transfer to UC must have completed IGETC AREA 6. This can be done with 2 years of High School Foreign Language or College Level Foreign Language Course with a letter grade of C or better.
