**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:**

The Associate in Arts in Art History for Transfer Degree is designed to give students a foundational understanding of art history. The primary focus is to prepare students for transfer into a four-year art history program at the California State University (CSU) system and the University of California (UC) system. Students will learn fundamental art and art historical terminology; an appreciation of the creative process; and how to analyze works of art in order to articulate the historical, social and aesthetic functions of art across cultures and geographic boundaries.

*Students who wish to transfer to UC must have completed IGETC - AREA 6. This can be done with 2 years of high school foreign language or college level foreign language course with a letter grade of "C" or better.*
