PROGRAM DESCRIPTION (3-5 sentences): brief narrative about program

This is a transfer degree for English majors. Completion of this major allows students to transfer to a CSU as a junior. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, a Bachelor’s degree in English leads to employment in adult education, remedial education, literacy, and GED teaching. Other fields that employ English majors include counseling, editing, interpreting, translation, and K-12 teaching. A BA in English is also considered a rigorous, complementary education for careers in the legal profession including lawyers, paralegals, judges, and clerks. (Some professions require further certification, testing or degrees.)
Students who wish to transfer to UC must have completed IGETC - AREA 6. This can be done with 2 years of high school foreign language or college level foreign language course with a letter grade of “C” or better.
